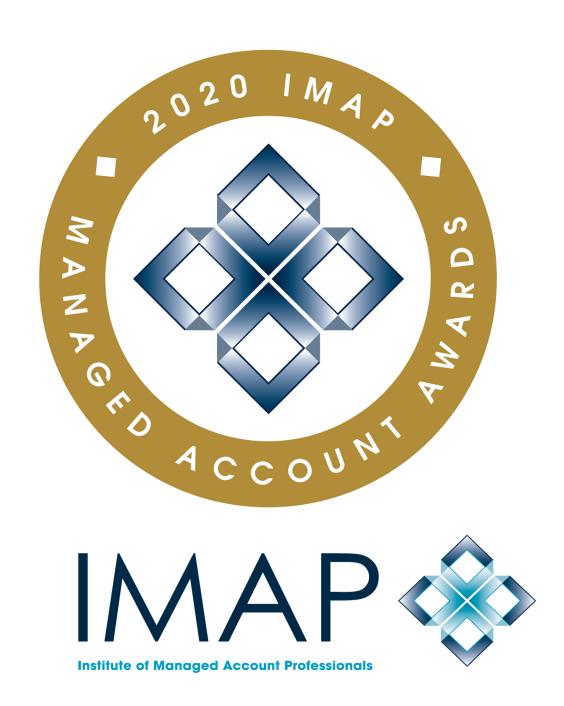
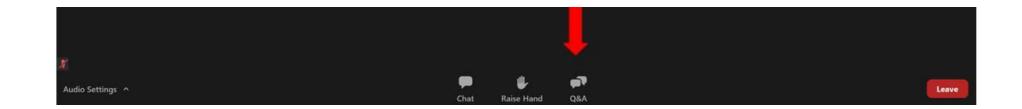

# Judging Criteria Overview

- Mix of Qualitative and Quantitative factors
  - Uses proven ratings criteria (process, people, track record and fees etc)
  - Fixed weights (70% qual/30% quant); differs for Licensees (80%/20%) & Innovation (all qual)
  - Versus peer group of Award entrants
- Client collateral and advocacy of managed accounts recognised



# Qualitative Factors

- General Award Categories (Asset Class & multi-sector)
- Philosophy and risk return objectives
- Quality of investment process including SAA and TAA
- People Quality investment team & IC and governance
- Client Collateral / Engagement / supporting materials

## Innovation Category

- 'Genuine' innovation such as technology
- Test with licensees, custodians, platforms and others



# Quantitative Factors

## Track Record (Asset Class & multi-sector)

- Usually short track records (1-2 years)
- Compare vs benchmark and portfolio objectives

## Fees (model manager)

- Input by IMAP ranking via client balance categories
- Focus on latest year



# **Judging Process**

- Written submissions (cut-down FSC), quantitative template and examples
  of client collateral
  - Judging Panel reviews by asset class and awards category over a number of months; decision by consensus
  - FEFundInfo provides quantitative analysis
- Finalist interviews for Licensee and Innovation Awards.
